Man Dies In Friend's House

LOISOKEREKE

A 42-year-old man, Ernest Kpen Nelson has died in the residence of his friend, Mr. Kingsley Nwanegbo.

The incident occurred at about 6.00am at No3, Ogundimu Street in Iju before the deceased could be taken to the hospital.

In a statement made to the police, Mr. Nwanegbo

said his deceased friend had been living with him since he returned from Ghana in May this year. He said Nelson was suffering from tuberculosis and had been undergoing treatment before his sudden death.

He also stated that he only agreed to accommodate the deceased because he had squatted with him

in the past and that he was one of the pastors in his church before his trip to Ghana.

P.M.NEWS learnt that the deceased had gone to the General Hospital in Yaba four days earlier where he was receiving treatment and was already getting better.

According to Mr.

Nwanegbo "the deceased's condition got worse in the early hours of that day (Tuesday this week) and before we could take him to the hospital, he had already died."

The incident was reported at the Iju Police Station where the suspect was detained for further interrogation.
