Death Of Chinese Woman: Association Threatens Protest

he Frozen Fish and Chicken Sellers Association in Apapa local government area of Lagos State, has threatened to take to the streets if the police do not properly investigate the murder of a Chinese businesswoman, Mrs. Wang Kive, who was assassinated last month.

The association, in a press statement made available to *P.M. News*, accused men of Trinity Police Station, who conducted previous investigation into the case, of not being fair to the family of the deceased.

The association called on the Lagos State governor, Mr. Babatunde Raji Fashola and the Commissioner of Police, Mr. Muhammed Abubakar, to look into the matter and provide security for Chinese businessmen in the country, who now feel unsafe.
According to the association, Mrs. Kive had been in the fishery business since she arrived Nigeria and

since she arrived Nigeria and therefore called on the Commissioner of Police to check the Koreans in the fishery business in the country as they may not be unconnected with Mrs. Kive's murder.
