

Man Killed In Car Crash

A man lost his life when the car he was travelling in crashed into an electric pole at Adetokunbo Ademola Street, opposite Eko Hotel, Victoria Island, Lagos, at the weekend.

P.M. News learnt that the deceased's friend, who was the driver of the car, was drunk while driving. He sustained serious injuries and was taken to the General Hospital.

The crash was said to have disrupted electric supply to Karimu, Kotun and Ososa streets

in Victoria Island.

The crashed car, a Toyota Camry with registration number HC 520 AAA, belongs to a security company in Victoria Island.

A witness to the incident, Musa Abdulahi, a cigarette seller, told *P.M. News* that the driver was coming from Ajah.

According to him, a commercial motorcyclist emerged from one of the streets and was directly opposite the car. The driver, while trying to avoid colliding with the motorcyclist, rammed into the electric pole.
