## Robbers Kill Guest At Naming Ceremony

Armed robbers last night shot and killed a guest at a naming ceremony near Haruna bus stop, along College Road in Hako, Agege.

The incident occurred at about 10 p.m. when about four armed men dispossessed a man of his Mercedes Benz ML ieep.

PM News learnt that one of the guests at the ceremony of a youth leader (names withheld) had thrown stones at the robbers, obviously in sympathy with the victim of the robbery operations

The robbers, who were driving off in the vehicle, were said to have become angry and fired several shots at the guests at the naming ceremony, and in the process, three persons were hit and sustained injuries.

P.M.News learnt that one of those shot by the robbers, Kayede Amos, 26, a painter, died at about 2 a.m. today at the
