Mad Man Charged With Murder?

35-year-old mentally challenged Adeyemi Adeniyi, yesterday appeared before an Ebute-Metta Chief Magistrate's Court for allegedly killing a motor mechanic. Kehinde Olowo.

The prosecutor Inspector Abosede Onasanya, told the court that the accused allegedly killed Olowo by hitting him on the head with a pestle Onasanya alleged that

Adeniyi committed the offence when Olowo was returning home from work at about 8 p.m. on October 8, at 3, Bune Street, Egan-Isawo, Ikorodu, the victim's residence.

She said that Olowo was passing by the accused's house, when Adeniyi attacked him-with the pestle.

The prosecutor said that there was power outage on the street when the incident occurred.

Adeniyi was also said to have earlier on the day of the killing, gone berserk, breaking the window of his mother's room and damaged some property there, including a television set.

Onasanva, who said that Adenivi was certified by a psychiatrist as having mental problem during police investigation, prayed the court not to grant him bail as he could be a menace to the public.

She urged the court to forward the case to the Director of Public Prosecution (DPP) for advice.

The plea of the accused was not taken, as the presiding Magistrate, Mr. F. O. Ogunkanmi, ordered that he be remanded in prison custody while the case file be forwarded to the DPP.

He adjourned the case till November 30.
