

Assassins Kill Biz Man

A Lagos-based businessman has been shot dead by suspected assassins.

The deceased, identified as Prince Ndulue, 55, was killed in his Mitsubishi L300 bus marked EW 762 EKU by two unidentified gunmen. The assassins escaped in an ash colour Toyota Camry car after the shooting.

A source told *P.M.News* this morning that he was driving towards Satellite Town at about 11.40 a.m. on Sunday, when the killers attacked him at Abule-Osun area.

The gunmen shot at him but missed their target initially, said the source.

"At this point, the victim tried to escape and drove at top speed to avoid the gunmen," said our source.

He was not so lucky as the assassins caught up with him and shot him in the chest several times.

P.M.News learnt that before he was killed, a passport photograph of the person who sent them to do the job was shown to him and they made sure he was dead before they left the spot.

His corpse has been deposited at the General Hospital, Broad street, Lagos Island.

The incident is being investigated at the State Criminal Investigation Department (SCID), Panti, Yaba.
