

Robbers Kill Cop, Cart Away Money

Arméd robbers yesterday killed a policeman guarding a bank in Ikere-Ekiti, Ekiti State, and removed a huge amount from the bank, an eye-witness said.

The witness told the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) that the robbers arrived at the bank about noon, shot the policeman on duty at the bank premises and removed his gun.

The witness said he sustained injuries in the attack.

Efforts to get the bank manager to speak failed as the workers prevented access to

her.

However, the Commissioner of Police in the state, Mr. Yomi Onashile, con-

firmed the incident and said the Police had swung into action to apprehend the crimi-

nals.

Onashile confirmed that one policeman was killed in the incident.
