2 Lovers Die In Apartment Fire

Tragedy struck in the early hours of yesterday at liggamo community in Ojo Local Government when fire broke out in an apartment and burnt two lovers to death.

The victims, identified as Balogun and Iyabo died in the fire that was suspected to have

started from Iyabo's room, eventhough the cause of the fire could not be ascertained at press time.

P.M.News gathered that Iyabo, a resident of the house on Ijegun road, where the incident happened was Balogun's lover. Balogun liveed in Ijegun with his wife and five children.

We learnt that Balogun left his family on Sunday for Iyabo's

house and he decided to spend the night in her house.

Neighbours, however, prevented the fire from spreading to other houses in the area.

When P.M. News visited the scene of the incident yesterday, a team of policemen were seen making arrangements to convey the charred remains of the deceased to Ikeja General Hospital.

Some of the shocked residents were seen gathered in groups, discussing the incident while lyabo's neighbours were busy packing back the properies they removed from their houses when the fire started.

At the Isheri-Osun Police Division, none of the officers was ready to discuss the matter. They said only the DPO

Yahoo Boy Stabbed To Death In Bar Bra

suspected Internet fraudster, known in local par-lance as Yahoo-Yahoo boy, Sharafa Adebayo, a.k.a. Ibadan, has been stabbed to

death at a birthday party.
It was learnt that a fight broke out during the party, held at a hotel on Alimi Ogunyemi Street, Off College Road, Ifako-

ljaiye, over an unidentified lady. *P.M.News* gathered that the deceased was in the company of his friends at a nearby bar at Otunubi Street, when three other friends came to invite him to a party.

Sources at the scene of the incident said trouble broke out when Adebayo was dancing with a girl whose boy friend was around. This led to a free for all during which bottles and other handy weapons were freely used.

As the fight peaked, Adebayo was stabbed in the eve and the neck, while he was allegedly hit on the head with a piece of wood.

Meanwhile, a lady and two men are now being interrogated at the Area 'G' Police Com-mand, Ogba in connection with the incident.

P.M.News learnt that Adebayo's suspected killers came from Oluwole Estate, not far from the scene of the attack.
