Ghastly Accident On Lagos-Ibadan Expressway

There was a ghastly motor accident along the Lagos-Ibadan expressway this morning, when a truck crashed into a tree near the popular Grema Mohammed New Kara Market, a few kilometres from Berger Bus stop.

P.M.News findings in the area revealed that the vehicle with registration number

Lagos XR 145 MUS, belonged to NWYT Trucks.

The number of casualties could not be ascertained as at the time of filing this report, but *P.M.News* gathered that the truck was conveying gravel to Lagos.

At the scene of the accident, some parts of the truck were seen mangled, while other parts were detached from the body.

in Jos, the Plateau State capital, has pleaded for the remains of his son to be released to the family for immediate burial.

According to a family source, the mother of the boy has been hospitalised as a result of the trauma of having to wait for her son's corpse indefinitely.
