How 5-Month Pregnant LASTMA Staff Was Killed

The families of Adenuga and Nasir are still grieving over the cruel murder of their daughter, Mrs. Temitope Adenuga-Nasir, a five-month old pregnant staff of the Lagos State Traffic . Management Authority (LASTMA) on Victoria Island, Lagos.

Temitope, who holds a Higher National Diploma (HND) in Business Administration from Yaba College of Technology, was five months pregnant when a danfo (commuter) bus ran over her while on duty on Victoria Island.

She died on the spot, while the heartless driver of the bus was said to have escaped.

Despite the N645,132 insurance cover the family of the deceased received from the Lagos State government, they are still grieving over the loss of their daughter.

Jumoke Adenuga, sister of the deceased LASTMA staff who collected the insurance claims from the state government lamented her demise. The late Temitope's husband, Mr. Yusuf Nasir, in tears, told P.M.News how his wife died.

"We live in Surulere and we attended the same school before we got married. She read Business Administration.

"She was my best friend and she was like a mother to me. She was everything I wanted in a woman. She used to assist me a lot in prayer," he lamented.

Mr. Umoru Yahaya, another LASTMA staff, died of cardiac arrest. His son, Mr. Shakiru Yahaya, described his father as a man of worthy character.

"He was the best man in my life. He was the sweetest man to me. September 8, 2008, was the saddest day of my life.

"On that day, I and my father played together in the morning. He told us good bye and went to work and we were later told that he had died. Nobody can ever replace him in my life," he lamented.
