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Jobless Youth Kills Colleague[Print version](#)

A jobless youth, Lekan Adeyinka, 18, has been arraigned before Yaba Chief Magistrate Oluyemisi Adelaja, for allegedly killing his colleague.

The prosecutor, Cpl. Chinalu Uwadione, told the Chief Magistrate's Court that Adeyinka had a misunderstanding with the deceased, one Saheed, popularly known as 'Mopol', over money extorted from commercial buses.

Uwadione explained that the quarrel led to a fight during which Adeyinka used a broken bottle to stab the deceased in the left hand.

He said that the stab cut through Saheed's vein and he later died at a hospital in Oshodi, Lagos, where he was receiving treatment.

The prosecutor said the incident occurred on April 13 at about 7 a.m. at the Railway Line, Oshodi Bus Stop, Lagos.

Uwadione said that the offence was contrary to Section 319 (1) of the Criminal Code of Lagos State and punishable by death.

The court did not take Adeyinka's plea but the magistrate ordered that he be remanded in prison custody, pending the advice of the Director of Public Prosecutions.

The case was adjourned till July 24 for further hearing.

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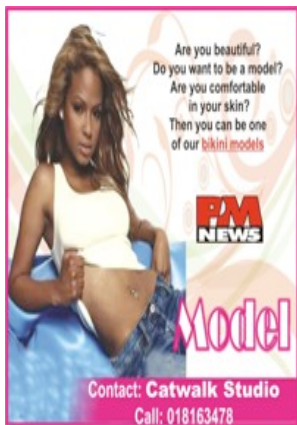
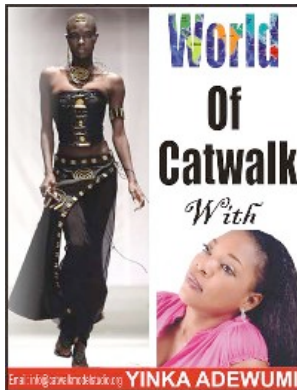
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
