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Sergeant Kills Man Over Quarrel With Lover

A trigger-happy police sergeant, Olowojoyin Abolade, attached to Iponri Divisional Police Station, Lagos, is now cooling his heels at the homicide section of the State Criminal Investigations Department (SCID), Panti, Yaba, for allegedly killing a man, Yussuf Omole Oladipe, who was involved in a row with his lover.

He reportedly pulled the trigger of his gun and killed the victim about 10.30p.m. along Ademuyiwa Junction, Apapa Road, Ebute Metta, Lagos, in order to please his lover who sells cooked food and resides in the area.

According to an eyewitness' account, "The food seller had on Wednesday last week reported Yussuf to her lover, Olowojoyin, about the quarrel between her and the deceased who came to buy food from her in the evening while breaking his Ramadan fast."

During the quarrel, the woman reportedly rained curses on the late Yussuf and his mother.

She later reported the incident to the police sergeant.

The killer cop, it was learnt, was not supposed to be on duty on the day of the incident last Friday, but he reportedly went to work and embarked on a search, combing all the nooks and crannies of Apapa Road for Yussuf.

It was gathered that the sergeant found the victim in the company of his friends and made attempt to arrest him.

"We were baffled when he alighted from a motorcycle along Ademuyiwa Street and headed towards Yussuf, telling him he was under arrest for an undisclosed offence," one of the deceased's friends revealed.

Sergeant Olowojoyin reportedly pulled the trigger of his rifle and shot Yussuf in the neck when the deceased demanded to know what his offence was, a source disclosed, adding, "seeing that his victim was writhing in pains, he shot into the air sporadically to prevent the mob from attacking him."

Yussuf's corpse was later dragged into a commuter bus by the sergeant and later deposited at Isolo General Hospital mortuary.

Speaking with P.M.News yesterday, the deceased's elder brother, Pastor Emmanuel Olu Omole, said Yussuf's death has destabilised the entire family, adding, "he was a promising young man and very cool-headed."

Commenting on the killing, the Special Adviser to the Chairman, Lagos Mainland Local Government, Bamidele Sulaimon, said, "We shall take it upon ourselves to ensure that justice is done."

Contacted, the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Lagos State Command, SP Frank Mba, confirmed the incident.
