took place in Ikorodu for some time, the people of the town are again experiencing another cult war between the *Black Axe* movement and the *Eiye* Confraternity, with lethal attacks being carried out in broad day light.

P.M. News gathered that the war in Ikorodu is a spill over from the current war between the two groups in Epe. Trouble started on Saturday in Solomade Street, beside the palace of the Ayangburen of Ikorodu, when during a social engagement, members of the two groups attacked one another, using all sorts of dangerous weapons including guns, axes and machetes.

It was also gathered that Musiliu Babatunde Giwa, an Engineering student of LASU, Epe campus, was gunned down on his way to the campus.
