

Youth Stabbed To Death

A 22-year-old man, Saheed Olaniyi, of Unity Street, Araromi Bus Stop, Adiyan, Ogun State, was allegedly stabbed to death by Godwin Asuquo, his friend's younger brother.

Until his death, Olaniyi, who is suspected to be an internet fraudster, was living with his friend, 25-year-old Emmanuel Asuquo, before his death.

P.M.News learnt from a source that Saheed had called three of his friends to inform them that he had just made \$54,000. Though he was yet to collect the money, he promised to settle them all as soon as he collected the money.

"Some people said they saw Olaniyi together with Emmanuel's girlfriend and Godwin, in Emmanuel's Toyota Camry car at Balogun Bus-Stop, Ishaga, and that they were arguing. The trio were later stopped at a police

check point. However, the police allowed them easy passage because they knew Saheed.

"The following day, somebody called Saheed's family to inform them that Saheed had been poisoned when he went out to drink in the company of his friends the previous day, adding that Saheed was dead, and that his body had been deposited at the mortuary. The family was also told that the caller was at the Agbado Railway Police Station.

"When Saheed's relatives got to Emmanuel's duplex, the main gate was open, though the doors to the building were locked. They walked about the compound and around the building only to discover blood stains everywhere. They immediately left for the palace of the traditional ruler (*Baale's*), who instructed them to go and report their findings at the nearest police station.

"From the *Baale's* palace,

they left for Agbado Railway Police Station, where they saw Emmanuel and Godwin, but they were not allowed in, even when Saheed's father arrived, he was not allowed in.

"When they were able to ask Emmanuel about what actually happened, he told them it was his younger brother that stabbed Saheed while they were fighting," adding that it was his girlfriend who came to wake him up when she saw bloodstains in the compound. By the time they arrived at the hospital Saheed was rushed to, he was already dead."

The DPO of the Police Station, CSP Olusola Oyewunmi, in a telephone conversation, told *P.M.News* that both Emmanuel and Godwin have been taken to the Ogun State Police Command Headquarters at Eleweeran, Abeokuta, Ogun State, adding that for further clarification, people should go to the station.
