

Man Docked For Murder

A man, Adeyemi Omolade, 39, has been arrested by the police at Dopemu, along the Oshodi-Abeokuta expressway, Cement Junction, Lagos, Nigeria, for reckless and dangerous driving.

Adeyemi was charged to court on a six-count charge of causing the death of Aminu Adamu, 18, and injuring others.

The accused, it was learnt, failed to stop to render assistance to the injured and also failed to report the accident to the police.

The offences are punishable under Sections 18, 20, 23, 27, of the Road Traffic Act, Cap.124, Vol.16, Laws of Lagos State of Nigeria.

He pleaded not guilty to the six-count charge and Magistrate Adepite granted him bail in the sum of N200,000 with sureties in like sum.

The sureties, she directed, must be gainfully employed and must show evidence of tax payment to the Lagos State Government.

The case has been adjourned till 21 June, 2010.
