

One Die In Auto Crash

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Tragedy struck along Ajah-Epe expressway yesterday afternoon when a man lost his life in an accident involving two vehicles, a red colour Nissan car with registration number MU813 KJA and an ash colour Toyota car with registration number KS 784 AAA.

The accident was attributed to dangerous driving.

The accident occurred around Elerongbe area, Okegun Village, along Ibeju-Epe Expressway, Epe Lagos State, Nigeria.

A witness told *P.M. NEWS* that the accident occurred when the unidentified driver of the red colour car going to Epe from Ajah tried to overtake a truck dangerously and in the process collided with the oncoming Toyota car going to Ajah from Epe.

The witness blamed the accident on the impatience of the driver of the unidentified red colour car.

Officials of the FRSC arrived the scene later to evacuate the two occupants inside the mangled cars to the hospital. One of them, it was learnt, sustained serious head injury while the other died.

FRSC Commander in charge of Epe Unit, Mrs. U.P.D. confirmed the accident, saying her men rushed the injured occupants to the Epe General Hospital and later contacted their families.
