

It was gathered that about thirty minutes after the tragic fall, at 1.30 p.m., other pupils who had also gone to ease themselves saw Lawal's still legs and alerted the school au-

thorities.

Lawal was brought out dead, with human waste all over his body, eyewitnesses said.
