According to him, " stopped at Ajilete checkpoint by the customs men and after checking our vehicle and no contraband was found, we were told to go. As Moruf started driving away I heard a gun shot and it

away I heard a gun shot and it hit him from the back of his head.

"He died immediately and I took to my heels. I ran straight to his family house in Ajilete and broke the sad news. Youths in the town on hearing the sad news mobilised themselves and went to confront the Customs men who fled their duty post for fear of being attacked by the youths.
