

Police Kill Robbery Suspects, Recover Car, Arms

The police at Ijaiye Ojokoro Police Station, Lagos State, southwest Nigeria, have killed two robbery suspects during an exchange of gunfire.

The police patrol team led by Inspector Nzerogun Robert, *P.M.NEWS* learnt, was in Ahmadiyya along Lagos-Abeokuta Expressway around 6 a.m when Mr. Adebayo Tajū flagged it down and told the policemen that he had just been robbed of his car.

The policemen, *P.M.NEWS* gathered, chased the robbers to Abule Iroko area in Ogun State

where the robbers numbering five stopped and engaged the police in a gun duel.

After the shoot-out, two of the robbers were killed while the other three robbers managed to escaped and abandoned the car, a Hyundai Elantra car marked EC952GGE.

When the dead robbers were searched, two locally made pistols and one live cartridge were found on them.

The car and the recovered items were taken to the police station where the car was handed over to the owner by the DPO in charge of Ijaiye Ojokoro Police Station, Mr.

Raji Murtala, a Chief Superintendent of Police, CSP.

Taju thanked the police for a job well-done and pray that God will continue to guide and protect them.

In another development, there was a report the at station that a yet to be identified driver of a trailer marked XU927SMK hit a pedestrian, Veronica Mbanara, at Meiran Bus Stop along Lagos-Abeokuta Expressway and escaped.

The victim was said to have died on the spot before help could reach her.

Traffic policemen took the corpse to a public mortuary. The case is being investigated.
