

Oshodi Killing Gang Arrested

• Blamed For Death Of Inspector, Corporal, Pregnant Woman

Men of the Special Anti-Robbery Squad, SARS, Lagos State Police Command have arrested three

members of the nine-man gang which killed a police inspector, a corporal and pregnant woman at Bolade, Oshodi, Lagos Southwest

Nigeria in September.

The suspects were arrested after a gun duel with operatives of SARS at Allen

Avenue, Ikeja, Lagos. The police also recovered N12.5 million from the robbery suspects while one of them was shot dead. Five of the suspects escaped.

Luck ran against them when the SP Abba Kyari-led SARS received a distressed call that members of the gang had dispossessed a woman, identified as Mrs. Nneka of her Hyundai Tucson Sports Utility Vehicle, SUV, with registration number CC 615 AKD.

The close circuit television (CCTV) installed in the area assisted the SARS men to identify the Hyundai Tucson.

Weapons recovered from the three suspects included AK 47 rifle, six live ammunition, 245 expended shells of AK 47, charms and a light green SUV.

The SUV snatched by the gang was abandoned while five of them escaped from the scene in a Toyota Camry saloon car.

One of the three arrested suspects, Ajibola Fatai Sulaimon, a.k.a Officer was identified as the leader of the gang.

P.M.NEWS gathered that detectives investigating the gang leader's robbery escapades have visited Igbaja, Kwara State to unravel some of his nefarious activities.

According to police sources, Sulaimon's confession led to the arrest of other suspected robbers, Kehinde Akin, a.k.a. Leyigbo and Augustine Olufemi Macaulay. They were arrested at their hideout in Ebute Meta, Lagos.

The suspects, it was learnt, have owned up to having three AK 47 rifles, one pump action and two locally made pistols. They also claimed that they specialised in snatching Toyota products like Prado and that they robbed companies based on information supplied by insiders.

On their past operations, it was learnt that the gang snatched N8.5 million in

Oshodi and N27.6 million in Ikeja.

A source at the SARS informed *P.M.NEWS* that investigation was ongoing into the activities of the gang. "We are also on the trail of the five fleeing members of the robbery gang," he added.

Police sources revealed further that during the gang's robbery operation at Bolade, Oshodi, the gang killed an unidentified Okada rider and Mr. Kayode Adebajji, a staff of the Nigerian National Petroleum Corporation, NNPC. Three other policemen injured by the gang were rushed to the Lagos State University Teaching Hospital, LASUTH, Ikeja.

A civil servant and father of three, Vincent Obodo, 43 has pleaded with an Otto-Ijanikin Customary Court, Ojo Local Government, Lagos, south-west Nigeria to save him from his second wife who, he confessed, was fond of beating him.

Testifying in the petition he filed against his wife, Angela, the divorce-seeking man accused Angela of beating him with broom and pestle whenever they fought.

Obodo told the court that he married Angela out of pity, adding that his decision to marry her as a second wife was a major mistake.

He said since he married her, he has not known peace. He also accused her of patronising soothsayers and native doctors and often acted on the good or bad information they gave her.

"I married Angela out of pity because we were childhood friends back in the village. I was already married with children when I met her again and the childhood love we once shared was ignited and an illicit romance kicked off.

"When our affairs became risky and my wife started suspecting our movements, I had to formalise our union by visiting her parents. I paid her bride price while I also performed all other marital rites," he said.

Speaking further, the Kokori-Delta State born father of three, said: "To avoid clash, I decided to let my wives stay in different apartments. But whenever I am with Angela, she would be so obsessed and ready to go to any length to see that I don't communicate with my first wife.
