On the Obakpolor committee set up by the government, Okunbor said, experienced people, including ex-pilots and veteran aviators should have been called upon to help.

He argued that because of all the taxes, airlines cut corners and put the safety of their passengers and crew at risk.

Okunbor was not specifically talking about Dana Airline, but at press conference in Lagos yesterday, the management of the airline dismissed alle-gations that it cut corners and endangered the lives of those who perished in the ill-fated flight 992 that crashed in Lagos State, southwest Nigeria.
Mr. Oscar Wason, Dana

Mr. Oscar wason, Dana Air's director of operations, dismissed reports that the air-line that crashed was the same one that had developed technical fault earlier.

He said: "This aircraft was neither the one that had any technical malfunction in Uyo nor was it grounded. Two days prior, the aircraft was on a scheduled maintenance for one of its A check and thereafter the aircraft was released for flight.

"The aircraft that crashed was 5N RAM. The previous aircraft that everybody is referring to that had declared an emergency is a different aircraft which is 5N SRI and that aircraft is momentarily in Istanbul for its heavy annual compulsory C check.

Dana Managing Director, Mr. Jacky Hathiramani, broke down in tears and explained that its airline abides by all the safety requirements in the

He said: "NCAA do perform audit on the airlines unan-nounced. They can do an audit every week, every month, it all depends. It's independently done and we are not advised when they are coming. Also

they perform round checks and they have been doing this very often. So as far as the authorities are concerned, they are do-ing their job and we are on the scrutiny always of the NCAA, only here in Lagos but across the network that we fly, in Kano, Abuja, anywhere we fly.

This aircraft came out of an A-check two days before and on Saturday, it flew its normal scheduled flights. On Sunday morning it flew two normal flights, 999 and 998 and it went heal to Abuse on a 903 and it back to Abuja on a 993 and it was returning to Lagos on a 992 which was involved in a crash

"The day before, Saturday, they did have VIP movement and the airspace was closed for close to 30 or 40 minutes.

20 Nigerians Deported From UK

At least 20 Nigerians were this morning deported from the United Kingdom and were dropped off at the Murtala Mu-

dropped off at the Murtala Muhammed international airport in Lagos, southwest Nigeria.
They left the United Kingdom at about 2 a.m. today on a chartered flight along with Africans from other countries, Mr. Morrison Robinson, one of the deporters said the deportees, said.

He said almost all the deportees had overstayed in the United Kingdom beyond the time permitted by their entry visas and were detained before being and were detained before being deported onboard a chartered Italian plane.

"We were many. They are still going to Congo and other African countries," Robinson said, looking at his two bags and expecting a relative to take him home.

He said that the cop who resided at Gowon Estate Police Barracks in Egbeda, Akowonjo area of the state and usually rode on a motorcycle to and from work on daily basis closed from work on the fateful day and

But when he did not report for work after some days, they called his mobile telephone, but it was switched off

They then called the immediate brother to the cop to inquire about him, but he was said to have told them that the family had also become worried that he had not come home for some days thinking that he was on a special duty in his office and that his phone line had been switched off since that time.

Following the unpleasant information from both sides according to the source, the police at Maroko swung into action and reported the matter to the Lagos

State Command, Ikeja, Lagos.
They also embarked on a
search mission of the cop by visiting all the hospitals in Lagos State to know if he was involved in an accident, but all to no avail

"We are still searching for him," he stated.

missing inspector's younger brother, Infeanyi Okwubor, for comment over the matter, he confirmed it and stated that they have been searching for their brother since April when he left home for work at Lekki with his motorcycle and that all efforts to find him have so far



Continuing, Mary said she had earlier told her Madam

that she wanted to go back to school which she agreed but later changed her mind and instructed her to remain as a housemaid. "While I was in her employ,

she paid me N15,000 monthly. saved the money and from it, rented an apartment. When I told her that I would go back to school, she initially agreed, but later changed her mind and instructed me to remain as her housemaid.

'I did not want anybody to see my corpse or cause my landlord and co-tenants any problem. That was what necessitated my going to the lagoon to end my life," she

explained in tears.
