

# Bus Driver Docked For Manslaughter

For allegedly causing the death of a pregnant woman, a commercial bus driver, Lekan Raji, was on Monday in Lagos charged before an Isheri Magistrates' Court.

Raji, 30, who lives at 22, Johnson Close, Yakoyo, Ojodu, Lagos, is facing a two-count charge of reckless driving and manslaughter.

The prosecutor, Inspector Nuhudeen Thomas, said the accused had on November 6 at 8.30 a.m. driven a commercial bus with registration number XSF 939 and caused the death of a pregnant woman, Funke Adesanya.

He said the accused allegedly drove his vehicle recklessly without consideration for other road users on Oremeta Street at Ojodu Berger area.

The offences, Thomas said, contravened Section 20, Vol. 45 of the Criminal Code, Laws of Lagos State.

Magistrate M.I. Dan-Oni granted Raji bail in the sum of N100,000 with two sureties in like sum.

The case was adjourned to November 28 for trial.
