Man dies of electrocution in Katsina village

An unnamed middle-aged man reportedly died of **electrocution** yesterday, in Kurtufa village of Batagarawa local government of Katsina state.

It was gathered that the deceased, whose identity is still shrouded in secrecy as residents declined to disclose his name, was found dead near a transformer where he was said to have gone to effect illegal repairs.

Some residents of the village, who spoke to our correspondent, faulted the Power Holding Company of Nigeria (PHCN) for what they described as neglect, insisting that the deceased stepped in to repair the light because they (PHCN) failed to do it.

An officer of the Nigerian Security and Civil Defence Corps, who did not want his name on print, told our correspondent that he was part of the team that went to rescue the deceased, saying, "he had died even before we got there."

He however added that the corps would investigate the matter.

Chief Imam of Kano dies at 81

The Chief Imam of Kano state, Alhaji Idris Kuliya Alkali died on Saturday, aged 81 years.

The late Kuliya Alkali died around 6.00pm at the Aminu Kano Teaching Hospital, Kano, leaving behind two wives and 20 children.

Before becoming the Chief Imam, the late Kuliya Alkali was in 1967 appointed the vice principal of Gumel Teachers College and later became the principal of the school.

In 1979, he became the registrar of the Kano state Sharia Court and later the Grand Khadi of the state in 1991 and also doubled as the Chief Imam of Waje Juma'at Mosque before he became Nigeria's ambassador to Kuwait from 1998 to 1999.
