

Six die, 22 injured in Gombe auto crash, says FRSC

The accident occurred in Gombe, North East Nigeria.

Six persons died on the spot while 22 others sustained injuries, following an auto crash on Dukku Road in Gombe township.

Kuteb Galadima, the Sector Commander of the Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC) in Gombe State, made the disclosure while speaking with newsmen in Gombe on Wednesday.

He said that the victims include five males and a lady, adding that some of the dead and injured had been taken to the Federal Medical Centre and the Specialist Hospital in Gombe.

Mr. Galadima said that the accident involved two vehicles, a trailer with registration number XA944 HJA and a mini-truck with registration number XA590 KWA.

The commander attributed the accident, which occurred at about 11 a.m. to break failure by one of the vehicles.

A witness, Sagir Audu, said that the driver of the trailer lost control and rammed into the mini-truck and later crashed into a shop.

He said that many of the victims were taken to hospital unconscious while some died on the spot.
