Two brothers nabbed for robbery, murder By NGOZI UWUJARE, Ibadan Thursday, July 26, 2007

Two brothers in Osun State have been held for alleged murder and snatching of motorcycles. They are Saturday Palmer and Sunday Palmer.

Sunday Palmer was alleged to have killed one Isiaka Rafiu, a commercial motorcyclist, at Ikire, on August 20, 2006, on his way to the farm and snatched his unregistered motorcycle.

Parading the suspects, the state Police Commissioner, Mr. John Moronike, said that one of the suspects took the motorcycle to Oke-Igbo and handed it over to his brother, Saturday to sell. Saturday, on the other hand, was arrested on June 28, for being in possession of an unregistered motorcycle belonging to a policeman.

Moronike said another suspect, Clement Sunday, was arrested in a hide-out along Akure-Ilesa expressway on July 9, 2007, after he escaped with bullet wounds after a shoot-out with vigilance group during a robbery operation in the Oke-Ominru area of Ilesa.

Moronike said before the suspect was sighted along Akure express road by the police patrol team, in the pool of his own blood, he had used his telephone handset to call for assistance, lying to his friends that he was involved in a motor accident.

Saturday confessed to Daily Sun that he killed Isiaka for making love to his wife. He said: "Isiaka had been sleeping with my wife. I warned him several times. I reported the matter to his colleagues, yet he never heeded my advice. It was when I saw him making love to my wife that I macheted him.'

Saturday, an Urhobo from Delta State, said it was an abomination for a housewife to have sex with another man.

He said: "I had to settle the score before it is too late." Clement Sunday, has, however, appeared before the Osun Magistrate's Court and was granted bail by the Chief Magistrate, Mr. Jide Falola. Moronike said Saturday and Sunday would appear in court after investigations.
