According to reports, the students had gone for menial jobs at the site to enable them raise funds to compliment the little they had collected from their parents for their financial needs in school.

According to an eyewitness, the duo had hardly settled down to extracting stones from existing mining holes when the earth suddenly collapsed on them.

The source who said the rain that fell the previous day compounded the situation as attempts to rescue the students by community members failed.
