Police kill female robber in Aba

Police from Ezizama Division in Aba, Abia State over the weekend, at about 7.30 a.m shot dead a female member of a robbery syndicate that specializes in car snatching within the South-East.

It was gathered that a gang of three, including the woman, had snatched a Toyota Camry saloon

car with registration No. Lagos: KSF 657 AR at gun point from its owner in Warri, Delta State, from where they drove to Enugu.

Consequently, Police across the zone were put on alert over the incident and they spread their dragnet to get members of the gang arrested.

Since the car was said to be fitted with tracking device, security operatives reportedly tracked the ve-

hicle to Aba, where policemen in the city were put on red alert.

However, last Thursday morning, policemen from the Ezizama Division, who were on routine patrol, saw the car being driven at Eggbule, Ezizama in Aba North Local Government Area with three occupants.

When the policemen flagged down the vehicle, instead of stopping, the three occupants allegedly

opened fire on the police team, which responded swiftly.

In the gun duel that ensued, the female member of the gang was gunned down by the police while the other two occupants of the vehicle escaped.

Police have urged doctors in the area to report anybody with bullet wound, who comes for treatment, to the nearest police division.
