In another development, three people have been killed and eight others injured in fresh attack on Bama, eastern part of Borno State by suspected Boko

Haram insurgents.

Sources said the gunmen attacked a community on the outskirts of Bama town with knives and cudget to slit throats of their victims last weekend. "They would have killed more than three people if the Civilian JTF had not intervened quickly," a source said, adding that troops also moved into the area when they were alerted.

Hospital sources said eight injured persons were brought to the emergency unit (names withheld) last weekend but could not ascertain if they came from

Bama.
