The information officer of Hadejia Local Government, Muhammad Garba Talaki confirmed the incident to Daily Sun, adding that the accident occurred as a result of a heavy downpour at about 6:00pm at Wadugur village in Ringim Local Government Area of the state.

He said the accident occurred while the palace guards were on their way to Aminu Kano International Airport to receive the Emir of Hadejia, Dr Adamu Abuibakar Maje, who was returning from Abuja.

He said a petroleum truck with registration number XA 847 GSH and an 18-seater coaster bus belonging to the royal guards of Hadejia emirate council, had a head-on collision and instantly went up in flames burning all the passengers in the two vehicles.
