

# 4 killed by cultists in Lagos

**A** 27-year-old suspected cultist simply identified as Seyi was killed by suspected members of a rival cult group at the Ajelogo area of Ketu on Tuesday and three others were shot dead yesterday at the Epe area of the state.

It was gathered that those who killed Seyi allegedly raped his wife and injure their nine-month-old baby. The Shomolu incident was said to have induced by Seyi's death.

Already three persons had been arrested by the police in connection with Seyi's death and were interrogated at Alapere Police Station before they were transferred to the State Anti-Robbery Squad (SARS), Ikeja.

The suspects were alleged to have beaten Seyi to a coma before slitting his throat. His killers were said to have accused his group of attacking some of their members at Ikorodu recently.

It was gathered that the deceased, an alleged marijuana seller and a member of Black Axe, lived near Saint Paul's Comprehensive College in Ajelogo, Alapere Ketu.
