Edo State Police Command. In the past, herdsmen were said to have in-

vaded one of the communities in the oil-rich state, where they allegedly killed 10 persons

who were on their way to the farm.

They were also said to be responsible for

the killing of the Head

of Personnel Management of Isoko North Local Government Area in Ogume last year.
