## Bauchi police raid black spots, run criminals aground

**T**he Bauchi State Police Command has recovered over 293 cartridges, 1081 rounds of arms and ammunition and 50 AK47 rifles at various hideouts of hoodlums in the state. Commissioner of Police, Mohammed Laden, told *Daily Sun* that police operatives, such as men of SARS, Ambush Patrol and Operation Thunder have given criminals in the state strong fight.

He said they raided black spots in the state to ensure peace: "We have totally raided black spots. Though some criminals escaped, we recovered a lot of arms."

He disclosed that men of Federal Highway Patrol on a routine patrol along Bauchi-Gombe Road intercepted a Peugeot 505 station wagon with Reg. No. Kano A411GAK, driven by one Mustapha of Dusten Tanshi, Bauchi, in company with one Ali of Chibok Local Government Area: "Also, we discovered 2016 brand

new single barrel guns, 293 cartridges and 20 expended cartridges.

He said a Nigeria Army captain attached to JTF Jos, Plateau State, reported the incident to State CID Bauchi, that a gang of armed robbers tied a lady of Iluada Ring Road, Jos, and robbed her of a Toyota Highlander SUV with Reg. No. LND 940BJ valued at N6.5 million.

He said police pursued the robbers and in the process shot one of the robbers, identified as Friday, while Kingsley and others escaped and abandoned their vehicle. One AK 47 rifle with 55 rounds of live ammunition, one locally made pistol with five rounds of cartridge were recovered, as exhibit while the case was transferred to "A" Division, Jos.

Laden added that a gang of 10 armed robbers attacked and killed some persons including Malam Ila, 87; Alhaji

Sanusi, 55 and Malam Musa Kallamu, 88; all of Gwadim village in Tafawa Balewa Local Government area after robbing them of the sum of N1.2million. He said his

men swung into action and arrested two suspects with seven expended 7.62mm ammunition recovered.

He stated that the police and vigilante group arrested one Anas of Madina Quarters, Bauchi, at Fadama Mada with cable wire valued at N5.6million. He explained that they were later identified to have vandalized NTA transmission mast at Warinje Mountain. Two suspects were arrested in connection with the case.

The CP said the CID Bauchi lead by Sola Knight (DSP), on a patrol and raided criminals' hideouts and recovered an Honda Civic Car with Reg. No KET 766AA containing 22 jerry cans, 22 gallons loaded with palm oil and groundnut oil. He stated that based on intelligence report, police patrol team attached to Ningi Division intercepted gunmen suspected to be insurgents at Gadan Maiwa village.

One of the suspects sustained serious injuries and was arrested and taken to the hospital and later died. They recovered 1081 rounds of 7.62mm short live ammunition, 12 loaded magazines; eight empty magazines, 11AK47 rifles; four Nokia handsets; four Hi-watt batteries for IED including cables and one Toyota Starlet.
