

Cultists kill 2 cops, bus driver in Port Harcourt

Two policemen were reportedly shot dead by some gunmen suspected to be cultists in Port Harcourt, Rivers State.

They were killed at about 8:35pm on Thursday, at the popular Ikokwu Junction, Mile 2, Diobu, Port Harcourt. The gang also shot dead a bus driver.

Saturday Sun investigation showed that the gunmen were walking freely along the busy road, when they saw the policemen and shot them, before shooting the bus driver.

It was gathered that after shooting their victims, the men walked away unchallenged.

A source told *Saturday Sun* that, in the last few days, some suspected cult groups, especially the one that goes by the appellation 'Aromates', had been terrorising the area.

Recall that in the last one week, there had been repeated shoot-out in some parts of Port Harcourt, the state capital.

It is also believed that the cultists perpetrated the fire incident that gutted the popular Mile One Market, Diobu.

Meanwhile, when the state Police Public Relations Officer, Ahmad Muhammed, a Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP), was contacted, he declined knowledge of the incident.
