

4 die in Delta road accident

Four persons lost their lives in a motor accident which occurred yesterday along the Warri-Sapele Expressway in Delta State.

Eyewitness told Daily Sun that the incident occurred when the driver of a taxi cab carrying six passengers was trying to overtake a trailer but could not make it and the trailer driver who was also trying to avoid a bad spot hit the taxi

while attempting to cross to the other lane but it was too late as the taxi somersaulted several times.

Consequently, the four passengers at the back seat of the taxi died instantly while the two persons in the front seat and the driver

were seriously injured. Also the trailer driver and his apprentice sustained injuries.

Daily Sun gathered that the injured were taken to a nearby hospital while the remains of the dead were deposited at the hospital morgue.
