

3 killed as farmers, herdsmen clash in Adamawa

No fewer than three persons have been killed in a free for all between farmers and herdsmen in Prambe, 10 kilometres from Dumne in Song Local Govern-

ment Area of Adamawa State.

Daily Sun checks revealed that trouble started when a farmer, a Yungur man of Prambe village in Waltadi district of the local government was allegedly killed on his farm by herdsmen.

It was also gathered that when other farmers heard the news, they mobilized themselves and killed two herdsmen in return.

When contacted on phone, the Police Public Relations Officer of the Adamawa Police Command, DSP Mohammed Ibrahim,

confirmed the incident. He said three people died in the incident, adding that investigations were ongoing on the matter. Ibrahim also told Daily Sun that a detachment of policemen had been despatched to the area to address the situation and prevent reprisal attacks.
