

# Robbers kill man in Warri

**T**ragedy struck in Warri, Delta State over the weekend, as a 56-year-old trader was shot death by hoodlums.

Daily Sun gathered that the victim, simply identified as Law Vincent, was in his store when some hoodlums stormed the place at about 8:30pm at the Warri Main Market.

It was learnt that the bandits numbering about five went straight into the store and collected the days sales from the daughter of the deceased at gun point.

Narrating her ordeal, the lady, simply identified as Ifeoma, told Daily Sun that her parents were waiting for her outside for her to lock the store.

According to her, the robbers shot severally into the air before collecting the money, saying her father however engaged the hoodlums in a fight and started dragging the money with them.

She said this might have angered the gunmen, who shot her father severally on the chest.

Sources said the deceased was rushed to the Central Hospital in Warri for medical attention but died on the way. His corpse had been deposited at the hospital morgue.
