

# Students on rampage in Kano over death of colleague

A group of angry students yesterday razed a truck and destroyed several cars in Kano in protest of the death of a colleague in an auto accident.

The mob action, which occurred at about 1.30 pm, followed an accident in which the truck crushed a 15-year-old student to death along Airport Road by Eldorado Junction in the city.

The riotous students, largely from Maikwanshe Secondary School, Kundila Secondary School and Dabo Secondary School, realising that the driver of the vehicle has escaped, set the truck ablaze. Not satisfied, the students descended on vehicles parked at the premises of two missionary schools in the state capital, St Louis Primary School and St Thomas Secondary

School, Kano, smashing some of their windcreens.

The mob action threw some parts of the state capital into panic before it was eventually brought under control by the police.

Confirming the incident, Police Public Relations Officer in the state, ASP Magaji Majiya, said six persons were arrested in connection with the incident, adding that the police were able to rescue the

driver from the mob.

He also said that the corpse of the deceased had been deposited in the mortuary, adding that normalcy has since been restored in the affected area.
