DPO kills hotelier in Osun From BAMIGBOLA

andemonium broke out yesterday in Ilesa, Osun State, as residents of Ijamo and Otapete areas of the town protested alleged killing of an hotelier, simply identified as Monday by a senior police officer (names withheld) of B' Division, Ilesa.

Dependable sources told Daily Sun that Monday was allegedly shot twice in the stomach at about 10:00a.m on Tuesday by the Divisional Police Officer (DPO), who led a police team that raided his brothel located in Ijamo area of Ilesa.

It was gathered that an unidentified corpse was allegedly found behind the brothel on Sunday and the residents of the area promptly reported the matter to the Police, but nothing was done on the matter.

A source said: "During the raid, Monday, who is operating the brothel, came and inquired from the DPO what informed the raid on his business premises and apparently angered by his action, the DPO brought out a pistol and shot Monday twice in the stomach. He died on the spot and his mutilated body was taken away in a police van." The State Commissioner

of Police, Mr Ibrahim Maisahanu, confirmed that policemen were at the premises of the hotel to arrest the deceased for a murder case. He said the DPO had been

arrested and currently at the State Criminal Investigation Department (SCID) where his case was being investigated.
