Three armed robbers killed in Delta

hree suspected armed robbers yesterday, were shot dead by a military patrol team along the busy Airport Road in Warri, Delta State.

It was gathered that the felled bandits met their waterloo as they attempted to snatch a bag containing unspecified amount from the owner.

Sources said that the robbers had waylaid the unsuspecting man who had made withdrawals from a bank.

Investigation revealed that the man vehemently resisted the robbers attempt to snatch the bag. Nemesis caught up with the gang when the patrol team came to the scene and gunned down three of the bandits while two escaped with bullet wounds.

A witness told Daily Sun that the bandits parked their vehicle at the bank premises, pretending to be customers and even discussed freely with some traders selling their wares at the nearby stores.

"We were surprised seeing the boys, who possibly were in their twenties, struggling with the man that came out of the bank and, as God would have it, a military patrol team emerged from nowhere and killed three of the robbers in a gun exchange", said the witness who did not want her name in print.

According to feelers from various quarters in the oil city, bandits now operate in buses as part of their several strategies to beat law enforcement agents. It was also gathered that some hoodlums who operate in buses drug their passengers and take them to unknown desti-
