Security guard killed in Warri

There was pandemonium in Okere, a community in Warri, over the weekend when a security guard was allegedly killed by hoodlums, who also mutilated his body.

Daily Sun learnt that the deceased, popularly called old soldier, met his death in the early hours of Saturday when he was about going home after closing from work as a night watchman at about 5.30am.

Sources told Daily Sun that the guard had closed from his duty and was going home when tragedy struck.

The deceased, whose

name could not be ascertained at press time was waiting for an oncoming vehicle to pass before he could cross the road when he got what he did not bargain for as he was hit by a hail of bullets from armed persons suspected to be hired assassins.

Daily Sun learnt that as soon as the old soldier fell down, the hoodlums, who emerged from their hiding and in order to finish him, matcheted his head, eyes and nose until he gave up the ghost before they zoomed off.

Described as the most tragic incident since the beginning of the year, sympathizers wept profusely and cursed the assassins.

Although nobody has

been arrested over the incident by the police, the remains of the deceased

has since been buried in Kogi State according to Islamic rites.
