

Police recover head of beheaded boy

...Arrest 4 for killing 'mad man'

Ogun State Police command yesterday said it had recovered the severed head of a two-year-old boy that was beheaded recently at Ofada, Mowe area of the state.

The boy's head was severed from his body while he was tied to his mother's back.

The suspect, Mamodu Bashir Ibrahim, a Nigerien, who fled the scene immediately he perpetrated the evil act, also raped the boy's mother.

Police Public Relations Officer, Muyiwa Adejobi, who made the disclosure yesterday, further revealed that the suspect took the investigation team to Mokola area of Ibadan Oyo State.

His words: "The head was recovered in a bag in

the bush on Tuesday, April 22. He has confessed to the crime but still keeping some information to himself as to those who sent him to get the "commodity".

He added that the state commissioner of Police, Ikemefuna Okoye had directed detectives to intensify efforts to uncover the buyers of the human parts.

In a related develop-

ment, the Police operatives attached to Adatan division of the command, have arrested four suspects in connection to the killing of a suspected mad man.

The deceased, Kazeem Akindele, 35, believed to be of unsound mind was last Tuesday set ablaze for allegedly attempting to kidnap a 19-year-old girl.

Those arrested over the killing of Akindele included Fausat Ogunbiyi, Mariam Yahaya, Blessing Joseph and Nurudeen Adebayo.
