

Gunmen attack another Borno village

Suspected Boko Haram insurgents have again, attacked a border community in Borno State, killing at least one person. They also burnt many houses and shops, residents said.

Sources said that the insurgents invaded Ngoshe, a border town in Gwoza Local Government Area, south of Borno at the weekend, set houses ablaze and shot dead a resident who attempted to escape from the scene of the attack.

A resident of the area, Yohanna Musa, said the attackers who may have been around the hilly area, stormed the village at about 7pm last Saturday with Improvised Explosive Devices (IEDs).
