Court remands 4 policemen over murder

A Rivers State High Court, in Port Harcourt, has remanded four dismissed policemen in prison over murder case, pending the determination of their case.

The accused policemen, who until their dismissal, attached to the Special Anti-Robbery Squad (SARS) of Rivers State Police Command, include Sergeants Shedrack Ibibo, Anwuri Marcus, Monday Ogoligo and Corporal Olisa Emeka.

The trial judge, Justice D.W. Checchey, gave the directive when counsel to one of the accused persons urged the court to

remand them in police cell.

Also charged alongside the four men was one Chigbu Samuel, an Assistant Superintendent of Police (ASP). They were alleged to be involved in the murder of two friends, Michael Igwe and Michael Akor, in Oyigbo Local Government Area of the state, which occurred in June 2009.

According to the state counsel, ASP Samuel was not in court because he has not been dismissed from the Nigeria Police Force.

The men were indicted by the Director of Public Prosecution's report.

The matter was adjourned till June 5, 2014, for plea.
