Guard docked over Christmas Day murder

A night guard, Emmanuel Adeoye, was on Wednesday taken to a Lagos High Court in Igbosere for allegedly shooting a woman, Gloria Okiran, to death on December 25, 2010.

At the trial before Justice Raliatu Adebisi, the prosecution called a Community Development Association chairman in Meiran area of the state, Rasheed Adebambo, in proof of the murder charge.

Testifying, the witness told the court that he was woken up by the defendant at about 3 a.m. on the day of the incident, claiming that armed robbers had invaded the area.

Adebambo, however, said when he came out of his house, he saw the lifeless body of a woman.
