Four die in Anambra auto crash

State when a commercial bus fully loaded
with about eighteen
passengers, according
to an eyewitness, lost
control along OnitshaOwerri express way.

An eyewitness said
the bus loaded with passengers suspected to be

hoteliers from the Rivers State enroute Ibadan in Oyo State lost control when its front tyre burst at top speed. The victims who died instantly were one girl and two boys, according to the officials of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) in Ihiala while nine passengers seriously injured and were rushed to a nearby hospital by the FRSC members for treatment. The accident which around happened 10:45am on Thursday caused heavy human and vehicular traffic jam along the ever busy Onitsha-Owerri highway

as the FRSC official had hectic period clearing and controlling the traffic.
