

Big trouble for man who stabbed his friend

For stabbing his friend to death over a minor incident, Osmond Ifeanyi, 26, of the Kabusa Village has been nabbed by the police.

The suspect whom police say would soon appear in court, stabbed his deceased friend, one Obumneme Osigwe, resident of Shenty, also at Kabusa Village, after the two had a minor disagreement.

Police told Abuja Metro that the incident occurred on October 31, when after the deceased, who had a quarrel with his friend thinking everything was over was molested by Osmond alongside other members of his gang when he went out to buy akara.

What started like a joke according to the police soon turned out bloody, when Osmond, who felt terribly insulted by the deceased over the disagreement they had brought out a dagger and threatened to stab him. He was then prevailed upon by people around who pleaded with him to take it easy since they were all friends but he would not hear any of such plea. To please his intention, Osmond did his dare and dealt his friend some stabs after which the victim fell and bled heavily.

People that came to the scene after the stab took Obumneme to the hospital where unfortunately the doctor confirmed him dead from serious blood loss caused by the stabs.

The murder suspect was promptly arrested and taken to the police where he confessed to the crime but said he stabbed his friend in anger and that he didn't know he was going to die because he only wanted to teach him a lesson for being rude to him.
