Nurse stabbed to death, woman kidnapped in Aba

Tragedy struck at the weekend in the Over Rail area of Aba in Abia State after a female nurse identified as Nkechi, was stabbed to death while another woman was abducted in the capital city within the same period by suspected kidnappers.

It was gathered that one Chinyere Raphael Nwatakwochaka of No. 3 Agbarevo/Omuma Road had quarrel with a co tenant, identified as Gladys Leonard Nkechi.

It was gathered that shortly after the quarrel, Nkechi, who was the younger sister to Gladys

came to the house and went to Chinyere, who by then was cutting vegetable inside the kitchen, to inquire why she picked up quarrel with her elder sister.

Nkechi was said to have engaged in some altercations with Gladys and in the process dragged the latter out from the kitchen.

In the ensuing struggling, both were reported to have fallen on the ground and in the ensuing melee, the kitchen knife which Gladys was holding, pierced Nkechi's stomach and she died.

Her body was later deposited at a public mortuary in the city while police said investigations into the incident had commenced.

In a related development, a woman was also

abducted by gunmen believed to be kidnappers.

The woman, whose name was given as Christiana Olewe, who was reported to have returned from a medical trip overseas where she had kidney transplant, was said to have been kidnapped in her son's house at Umuokohia village in Obingwa Local Government.

It was gathered that the hoodlums broke into Olewe's son's house, picked some cash and other valuables before kidnapping and taking her to an unknown destination.

As at the time of filing the report, the hoodlums were yet to make demand for ransom.
