Truck driver kills man in Lagos

Somewhere in Lagos, a family has been thrown into mourning by cruel fate as an unknown man was on Friday night killed by a reckless Foton truck driver close to the BRT terminal at Oshodi, Lagos state. The man apparently was walking towards a nearby bus stop to board a commuter bus.

Sunday Sun gathered that the incident happened at 8:58pm. A bystander who witnessed the accident told Sunday Sun that the driver of the truck with reg-

istration number, FST497XN, identified as Kehinde Oluwadare was following a Toyota Camry car going in the same direction. Feeling that the Camry driver was slow, he wheeled out to the left in an attempt to overtake the car in front.

Just at that very moment, he saw a Toyota Sienna coming in the opposite direction on the lane, clearly against traffic flow. In a bid to avoid a head-on collision with the Toyota Sienna, the truck driver sharply swerved into the BRT Park and hit the unknown pe-

destrian from behind, killing him instantly and dragged his body some distance before stopping.

Upon stopping the truck, the driver attempted to escape from the scene, but for the vigilant area boys who held him until policemen from Makinde Police Station, led by one Inspector David arrived at the scene. The policemen took custody of the driver and drove him away in their van. The corpse of the man was later moved to a mortuary by the police.
