The Defence information said the situation in Baga was still being studied to determine the appropriate action that would restore law, order and normalcy to the community after the attack mounted by hundreds of heavily armed terrorists of last weekend. A total of 14 soldiers were killed in action during the at-

tack, while over 30 who were wounded are now receiving medical attention. Most of those declared missing in action have also rejoined their unit in the ongoing reorganization for further operations.
