Two policemen shot dead as robbers snatch workers' salaries

TWO policemen were shot dead yesterday when armed robbers waylaid a vehicle conveying the salaries of employees of Adavi Local Council area of Kogi State.

The robbers, after kill-

ing the policemen escorting the vehicle, carted away the money.

According to a witness, the cashier of the council, in company with some account clerks and policemen had gone to a first generation bank in Okene to cash the salaries running into millions of Naira

after which the hoodlums ambushed them at Ogaminana market area and opened fire on the vehicle.

The Council which is owing its workers over 14-month outstanding salaries was said to have decided to withdraw the sum in order to make table payment and by that, detect ghost workers in the

council.

As at the time of filing in this report, it was not clear how the robbers managed to escape from the scene. It was learnt that sporadic shootings by the robbers caused serious Panic and traffic gridlock at the ever busy Okene- Ogaminana highway.
